
Bharatimaiya College of Optometry, Surat is a new institute which has come up in the academic Year 2011-12. Since this is the first year of this institute, the details of actual expenses for the last two years of the institute are not available for consideration of the Committee. Therefore, looking to the fee structure available to established Optometry, the Committee approves on normative basis as the fees as a Deposit for the year 2011-12.

Fees as deposit per annum for 2011-12 :- Not Exceeding Rs.25,000/-

The Final fee structure will be approved after getting a fresh proposal from institution with details of Audited Accounts for the year 2011-12 . Fee specified above is to be adjusted by the students/institute as per the final fee structure.

Other conditions to apply :

- The college will not take fees for the full course at the time of admission. The Fees should be collected per term.
- The college will not ask for any bank guarantee or security of any kind from students or their parents.
- The college will not take any other fee, deposit, charge or advance in the name of gymkhana, computer center, internet facility, laboratory, library, sports, recreation, self development etc.
- The college will be free to fix fees for NRI students up to 15 % of the intake capacity subject to intimation of the same to the Fee Committee. The difference of amount of the fees from the NRI category students and Non-NRI category students shall be used by the institute for providing scholarship to the students and/or increasing infrastructure facilities. The institute shall also furnish all the information pertaining to the utilization of excess fees from the NRI category students as per the specified format in Part VIII and Part IX of the Information Memorandum submitted by the institute to the Fee Regulatory Committee.
