ORDER

**Sub.: Fixation of Fee Structure for the Academic Years 2015-16 to 2017-18 for
Medical Colleges running Post graduate Courses.**

1. The Fee Regulatory Committee(Medical) (here in after referred to as The Committee) has been constituted under section-9 of **The Gujarat Professional Medical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007, Act No. 3 of 2008** (hereinafter referred to as 'The Act') enacted by the Sate Government to make special provision, inter-alia, for fixation of fees in professional medical educational colleges or institutions for admission students. Hence, the Committee is empowered to determine the fee structure for Medical, Dental, Physiotherapy, Homoeopathy, Ayurveda, Optometry, Occupational Therapy, Orthotics and Nursing program in unaided professional colleges in the State. Your Institution falls within the purview of the Act and it is subject to the jurisdiction of the Committee.
2. In pursuance of the powers conferred upon it u/s 10(2) of the Act, the Committee invited the proposal of fee structure with required audited accounts and other details from the institution vide letter dated 24/12/2014.
3. The Committee carried out the scrutiny of the record and books of accounts submitted by management of the Institution. Based on the preliminary scrutiny and analysis of the details furnished to it, the Committee evaluated the facilities, infrastructure, capital investment made by the college, plans for development on hand and for future, compliance of requirements concerning the staff, cost estimates etc. for the purpose of fixing the fee structure for the institution.
4. Further, in accordance with provisions of section-11 of the Act, while determining and fixing the fees to be charged by the institution, the Committee also kept in view the relevant factors as prescribed u/s 11 of the Act.

5. In other words the Committee has fully considered the facts and figures as also the factors essential for determination of fee structure and only thereafter by following the Standard Operational Procedure for fee fixation, it has determine the fee structure of the institutions as per **ANNEXURE – III**.

6. The Committee also recommends the college to devise a fee structure proving for differential fee for the degree/diploma courses, provided the average fee from all the courses and from all the students as fees indicated in Annexure – III . The fee include all types and kind of fees such as Tuition Fees, Clinical, Library, Laboratory, Computer Centre, Gymkhana, Internet, Sports and Recreation and Self / Personality Centers etc except Hostel fee and Transportation fee. As such the college is advised not to collect any other fee from the students except the fees as in Annexure – III. Any such unauthorized collection of fee may invite punative action as per the law.

7. **For the present block of three years viz. 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18, Fee structure is three tier with stepped up fee.**

For inflation and development up to 10% of surplus has been given to every institution on fee determined for new students if it is less than the fee proposed by the institute but in no case the final amount has exceeded the fees proposed by the institutions.

The fee structure determined by this Committee shall be binding for the year 2015-16 to 2017-18. The fees so determined shall be applicable to the only new students admitted in that specific academic year only and shall not be revised till the completion of their professional course in that college or institution i.e. (1) the students admitted in the year 2015-16, the fees of 2015-16 are applicable to those students up to the completion of their course. (1) the students admitted in the year 2016-17, the fees of 2016-17 are applicable to those students up to the completion of their course. (3) the students admitted in the year 2017-18, the fees of 2017-18 are applicable to those students up to the completion of their course.

8. The College / institute is also advised to comply with following additional conditions:
- a. The College shall not take fees for the full course at the time of admission. The fees should be collected per semester / term of 6 (Six) months as the case may be.
 - b. In view of cost of securing bank guarantee, the College should, as far as possible, refrain from insisting on bank guarantee. The Committee advises that the College should work out an alternate form of security/guarantee to ensure that no student once admitted, abandons the course half way resulting into loss of opportunity for others. In this background, the college is free to work out an arrangement to ensure that the student leaving the course before completion pays the full amount of the Course for the entire term of two or three years as the case may be.
 - c. The institute will be not take any other fee, deposit, charge or advance in the name of gymkhana, computer centre, internet facility, laboratory, library, sports, recreation, self development etc.
 - d. The College shall not force on the students, any facility including hostel and transport as part of the condition for admission or its continuity till the end of the full tenure of the course.
 - e. The College shall notify the fee structure on the College Notice Board and display copy of this order on its Mandatory Disclosure Link on its web site.
 - f. **The College will be free to fix fees for NRI students up to 15 % of the intake capacity subject to intimation of the same to the Fee Committee. 75% of the difference of amount of the fees from the NRI category students and General category students shall be used by the institute for providing scholarship to the students and/or increasing infrastructure facilities. The institute shall also furnish all the information pertaining to the utilization of excess fees from the NRI category students as per the Information Memorandum submitted by the institute to the Fee Regulatory Committee in the next block of three years.**
 - g. The College is advised to work out a financial aid scheme through which it shall provide waiver or relief or concession in fees to the students belonging to weaker section of the society.

h. Any unaided professional educational college or institution that collects capitation fee or the fees in excess of the fee determined by the committee, shall be liable for action as per subsections (2) (i) and (2) (ii) of section 13 and section 14 of the Act.

9. This order has been made under section 10 of the Act hence violation of any of the provisions contained in it will render the management of the institution liable to be proceeded against under section 14 of the Act.
